Entry Fees:

Format:

- The American 900 Round will be used for the 2010 Washington Games
- 90 arrows will be shot as follows:
 - Senior / Adult / Young Adult
 - 30 arrows from 60 yards
 - 30 arrows from 50 yards
 - 30 arrows from 40 yards
 - Youth
 - 30 arrows from 50 yards
 - 30 arrows from 40 yards
 - 30 arrows from 30 yards
 - Cub
 - 30 arrows from 30 yards
 - 30 arrows from 20 yards
 - 30 arrows from 10 yards
- All archery events will be conducted in accordance with National Archery Association rules, except as modified herein.
- 'X' hits will be kept on the scorecard and will be used as a tiebreaker.
- Should equipment failure occur, a 30 minute repair time will be allowed with no disruption of the shooting line. A maximum of 2 ends may be made up at the discretion of the Archery Commissioner.
- Field glasses or scopes are permitted for spotting arrows.

- No broadheads will be permitted.
- Dividing lines are part of the higher scoring.
- Winner shall be the archer(s) scoring the highest number of points in each division and age group.

Registration Rules:

- Pre-registration is very much appreciated to ensure an on-time start and that there are enough targets available.
- **Registration deadline: July 1st, 2010**
- Archers must provide their own bows & at least six (6) matching arrows.
- Entry is limited to one category only.
- Participants can register using the official registration form, available online at www.washingtongames.org in the Archery section, and mailing the completed form with payment to the address on the form.
